As a registered charity based in Toronto, UforChange powers the next generation of entrepreneurial creatives as they shape their future as leaders in their community. We provide a supportive and collaborative environment for our young people, ages 16-29, to learn a combination of creative, practical and soft skills that will help them develop career paths and opportunities.

In 2015-2016 we connected 379 youth from all over the Greater Toronto Area with mentors, volunteer and paid opportunities, industry connections, and provided workshops and arts-related experiences. In cycle 10 and 11 we graduated 80 young people from our core arts programs: DJ, Fashion, Film and Photography.

IMPACT - STORIES



Since graduating from UforChange's cycle 11 film program, Camilla and Kevin are now active members of Toronto's film industry. After graduation, they began working with Black Belt Productions, a close partner with UforChange, where they take alumni on set to give them industry experience by working on videos for web and television, as well as documentaries.



Raheem joined Cycle 10 having never DJ'd a gig before. After graduating from our DJ program, Raheem has taught DJ lessons for our summer Turn It Out workshops, cycle 11 classes and continues to receive paid DJ opportunities through UforChange and his own connections.



Through UforChange's relationship with the Toronto Fashion Incubator, Abinaya from cycle 11 joined the Fashion Your Future program after graduation. She was able to take the skills she learned through UforChange's fashion program and apply them to produce a line of accessories. Since then, she has sold her scarves at Toronto Fashion Week's Press Buyers Brunch. Abinaya continues to stay engaged with UforChange and seek entrepreneur advice from mentors at UforChange.



The fashion program provides youth with the technical skills and industry opportunities to make their own garments, as well as the confidence to express their own unique style. Through the fashion program the youth attend field trips to Toronto Fashion Week, Fashion Arts Toronto, and learn how materials are produced here in Canada. They also learn about selling their collections and get one-on-one time with mentors to talk about their entrepreneurial goals.



Our DJ program teaches the basics on classic vinyl turntables, song composition, time signatures and technical skills such as beat-matching, mixing with vinyl and more. Mentors also advise youth on buying equipment, invoicing for gigs and client relations. By the time of graduation youth have the knowledge and confidence to DJ at events while UforChange connects them to gigs in the arts community. Our DJ program sets the beat of the city.



exploring street art to event From photography, the youth in the program learn it all. During the program, the youth learn how to use professional cameras, lighting techniques & equipment, how to edit their photos using industry standard programs, and how to start their photography careers. Through UforChange, the youth gain handson experience and paid gig opportunities. The youth practice their photography at community events such as Vivacity, Workshops in the 6ix and the Regent Park Film Festival amongst many others.



Our film program inspires participants to share their unique story with the world. Our youth do not only learn the essentials of expressing their own story, but they also learn how to shoot, produce, and edit a film from beginning to end, as well as film creative shorts and corporate videos. After graduation, the youth are ready for freelancing and come back for advice from their artist mentor regarding editing, pricing and gear rental.




SPECIAL WORKSHOPS

Our theatre program is a combination of improv, character development and script writing. This special program was led by a long-time UforChange artist mentor and alumnus who was trained at Soulpepper Theatre and Second City. With the help of b current, the youth learned about character development with a full session of trained actors. Throughout the program, Soulpepper offered advice on the youth's monologues for their main Vivacity performance. Thanks to Soulpepper the youth were able to watch their first production on stage and witness multiple live performances.



SPECIAL WORKSHOPS

In February 2016 UforChange launched Workshops in the 6ix, which provided shorttermintense learning for youth who could not commit to a 8-month program. We offered workshops on spoken word, business in the arts, grant writing and mobile photography as well as screen-printing and jewelry design with the help of the Design Exchange. The workshops were hosted by UforChange artist mentors as well as new mentors to engage new members with the UforChange family. Ufor Change engaged 78 young people from cycles 1-11 as well as youth who had never engaged with UforChange before.



MAIN EVENT

Vivacity is UforChange's annual multimedia showcase that brings over 200 people from Toronto to celebrate the artistic skills our graduates have acquired during the 8-month cycle. More than 50 youth and alumni work to deliver a professional show that includes an inspirational fashion show, a projection of short films and a photography exhibit all of which are accompanied by the music from the DJ program graduates. This special event does not only further cohesion amongst the community, but also acts as an invaluable skills-building project for the youth.



OTHER EVENTS

Turn It Out provided 8 weeks of DJ and dance workshops to the community led by UforChange alumni and funded by the Daniels Summer Series grant.

The Campaign for Wool is a 3-day event hosted by the Prince's Charities in which UforChange participated by planning and capturing the event with our videographers and photographers.

At **Canada's Flag Anniversary** our DJ Artist Mentor and 5 DJ youth provided music, thus allowing them to learn how to DJ a formal event.

Run Regent is a youth initiative started by Khadija, Cycle 10 DJ alumni, who reached out to UforChange staff and alumni to start the Regent Park running club.

The Regent Park Annual Community Clean Up is an event to keep the neighbourhood clean where UforChange helps plan, fundraise, recruit volunteers and provide photography and DJ services.

Sunday in the Park with CRC, Yonge Street Mission and other RP Programs is an annual community event to which we bring UforChange and community volunteers.

We Got Next in partnership with the Artscape Youth Mentorship program show-cased current youth and alumni's mixed media at YTB gallery.

We've Got Talent was a fundraiser with RBC where employees donated to UforChange while youth showcased their garments.

Improve & Dance workshops with Harbour-front Center allowed alumni Tony and Stephanie to host a one-day workshop.

AGO Youth Parties allowed for Ufor Change's female DJ's to blend their sounds for a crowd.
