Contract: September to May (34 weeks), 3 hours every Monday from 5:30-8:30PM. Hours will increase in April and May to support Vivacity (youth showcase).

Organization: UforChange

Mission: To mentor young people in the pursuit of their artistic and aspirational passions in an inclusive state.

Vision: Every young person confidently pursues a future rich with opportunity.

UforChange is a nonprofit that provides arts programming to young people ages 16-29. We also support young people with their educational goals, professional pursuits and personal endeavors. Our program is divided into 8-month cycles that intake 50 creative young people. At the end of each cycle, there is a final art showcase of youth artwork called Vivacity, which culminates the work they have created while in the program. Vivacity is a public event that is open to families and friends from around the city.

Contract Description:

UforChange is seeking an experienced cinematographer to teach a small group of young people introductory cinematography skills. Curricula should include, but not limited to: current cinematography trends, DSLR camera use, field trips, network of artist professionals to invite as guest speakers, video editing, screenwriting, mobile filming and editing for social media and professional development in the field. The artist mentor will have the ability to teach and engage the group of young people who have little to no skills in the respective art. The artist mentor will have the ability to develop their skills and track growth from class to class. Most importantly, the artist mentor will provide mentorship personally and professionally.

Primary areas of responsibility

- Teach weekly classes
- Plan and prepare weekly lessons
- Provide arts business guidance
- Maintain good order and discipline with your students both inside and outside the classroom
- Provide paid and unpaid opportunities in the field for your young people
- Work closely with the Program Coordinator
- Attend and participate in staff meetings and UforChange events
- Participate in any arrangements for further training and professional development
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of young persons for whom you are responsible and with whom

- Experience working with a diverse group of young people
- Excellent written and communication skills
